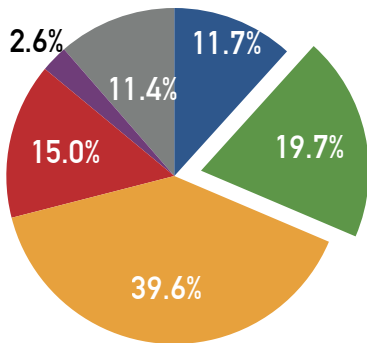
679 TOTAL U of G STUDENT PARTICIPANTS (4.2% decrease from 19/20):

406 in individual study/research, departmental, and co-op programs

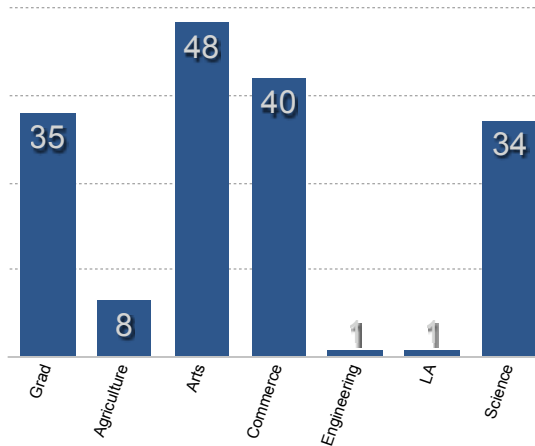
CIP provides pre-departure orientation and emergency response services for all students going abroad.

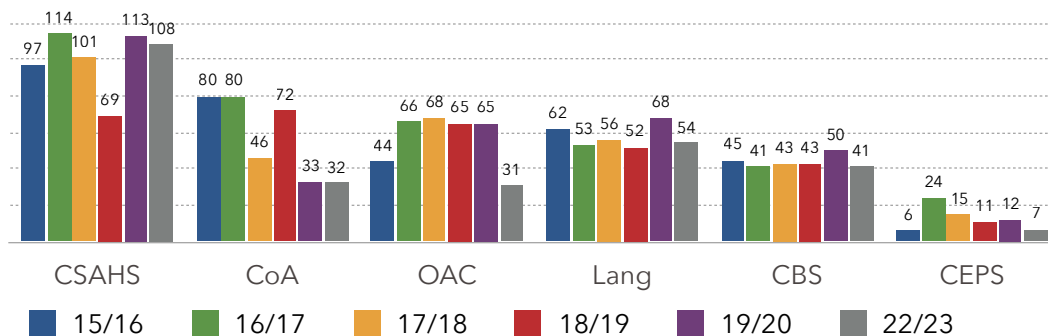
INCOMING EXCHANGE (Total 167)
