Postdoctoral Position Available

NSERC Visiting Fellowships in Canadian Government Laboratories

One position is available in the area of dietary fibre and gut health to study the functions of dietary fibre positive to human/animal nutrition and health that are mediated through the gut microbiota, beginning in April 2008. Applicants should have a Ph.D. degree in microbiology, molecular/cell biology, or a related discipline with research experience in functional genomics. Applicants with research experience in any of the following areas are invited to apply:

Gut microbiome, DNA microarray techniques, metabonomics,
proteomics, cell signalling, rodent biology.

The position is administered under the NSERC Visiting Fellowships in Canadian Government Laboratories program, and application should be made through NSERC to establish eligibility for the fellowship program as well as to Dr. Joshua Gong. Each successful candidate must pass a reliability security screening. Initial appointment is for 1 year, with the possibility of renewal for a further 2 years. The fellowships currently provide a stipend of \$43,724 / year.
