Dr. Levy will be receiving an Honorary Degree at the College of Biological Science Convocation Ceremony on June 13th.

Dr. Levy's research has been recognized at home and abroad. She is the recipient of several honorary degrees and in 2004 was named to the top 100 list of Canada's Most Powerful Women. She has also been decorated with a long list of distinctions and accolades, including Fellow of the Royal Society of Canada, Officer of the Order of Canada, and the Future of Vision Award recipient from the Foundation Fighting Blindness in 2001.

It was during her years of research at UBC that Dr. Levy recognized the therapeutic potential of light-activated drugs. She is a founder of QLT (Quadra Logic Technology) International best known for developing Photodynamic Therapies for treatment of various cancers and eye conditions. Visudyne, developed by QLT is used for treatment of wet age-related macular degeneration.
