- A selection of questions will be set from the above chapters and sections. Questions will be based on exercises in the lecture notes and the homework.
- Graphing calculator's are permitted. However, for graphical problems students will still need to justify the answers they give.
- The questions require written answers and typically have several part marks. Little credit can be given without correct mathematical justification.
- No notes or books are allowed in the exam (except in special cases arranged through SAS).
- The exam will be 50 minutes long and will comprise 25% of your final grade.
