Today is our big bottle drive collection day. Bring your family to help with collecting bottles for this very busy fundraiser!

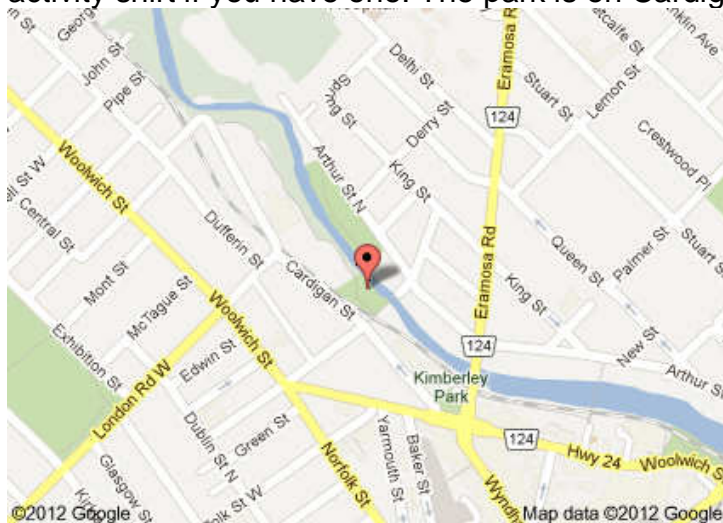
Monday, April 23rd, 2012
