The recipient of the Award will be on campus for 2-3 days in the Fall Semester to present his/her lecture, and to meet with and interact informally with students and faculty.

Nominations may be made by CBS faculty members as well as by Core Members of the Institute. The nomination should include a brief statement on the nominee's significant achievements and a current *c.v.*

The nominee should be an outstanding researcher who has national and international recognition in Aquatic Biology.
