Briefly, Patrick has been a faculty member @ the University of Guelph (UoG) since 1974 (Assistant Professor 1974; Associate Professor 1978; Professor 1984); was Director (2002), Axelrod Institute of Ichthyology; and Senate elected him University Professor Emeritus (2005). He founded *The Roy C Anderson Memorial Lecture in Parasitology* in 2001, and has been organizing the lecture series since its inception. Patrick was research supervisor to 17 MSc & 9 PhD students and 10 Postdoctoral Fellows, and NRC/NSERC has sponsored his research program since 1974.

Prior to 1974 he was Medical Research Council Postdoctoral Fellow & Ballard Fellow @ UoG; FAO Andre Mayer Research Fellow @ East African Trypanosomiasis Research Organization & @ Serengeti Research Institute; and IDRC Consultant & Visiting Scientist @ Nigerian Institute for Trypanosomiasis Research.

Other 'external' appointments (1985-2012) include as: NUS Visiting Research Professor, National University of Singapore; CNPq Visiting Scholar, Universidade Federal do Rio de Janeiro, Brazil; MEC Research Fellow, Instituto de Acuicultura de Torre de la Sal, Spain; and Research Fellow, Universiti Malaysia Terengganu, Malaysia. He was also Short-term Visiting Professor @ 4 other universities; Visiting Scientist @ 6 institutions; Ext. Examiner of 17 PhD theses; Assessor for Academic Appointments & Promotions @ 12 universities; Assessor of Academic/Research Programs @ 3 universities; and Research Consultant (10 consultancies).

He received *The Robert A Wardle Award* 'for contributions to Parasitology'; was founding Treasurer and Trustee, Zoological Education Trust; Fellow, The Royal Society of Tropical Medicine and Hygiene, UK; and Member, New York Academy of Sciences. Patrick is the current Executive Editor of *Journal of Aquaculture Research & Development*, and he also serves on 3 editorial boards
