Originally from Chile, Dr. Maurice Bitran is among the most highly placed Hispanics in public administration in Canada. An Assistant Deputy Minister in the Ontario Government, Dr. Bitran has headed the Secretariat of the Premier's Jobs and Prosperity Council, the Strategic Policy Division at the Ministry of Economic Development and Innovation, and was Ontario's chief negotiator for the free trade negotiations between Canada and the European Union. He is the 2012 Ontario Fellow in Public Policy and Governance at the University of Toronto. He is an advisor to the Toronto Hispanic Chamber of Commerce.
