Title: "Civil Society and the Social Construction of Citizenship."

Description: This talk will be based on Dr. Oxhorn's most recent book, *Sustaining Civil Society: Economic Change, Democracy and the Social Construction of Citizenship in Latin America* (University Park: The Pennsylvania State University Press, 2011). Starting with a critique of T.H. Marshall's classic work on citizenship, it will develop three models of citizenship that are determined by the nature and relative strength of civil society. These models are citizenship as co-optation, citizenship as consumption and citizenship as agency.
