Brief Course Synopsis:

This class is intended as a foundation course where students can learn the basic language and techniques of theatrical design in order to further develop this understanding in advanced design courses. It has also been created to expose the language of design to future teachers, performers and theatre practitioners.

Although basic design elements of composition, colour, line, perspective and technical drawing will be covered, the focus of this course is the communication of meaning in a text: understanding how a designer collaborates and communicates with the audience, actors, directors and technicians in order to produce meaning in the theatre. This production of meaning involves in-depth reading and analysis of the script, intuitive and intellectual response to this analysis and the questioning of assumptions regarding interpretation, staging and visual choices at every step of the way.
