Brief Course Synopsis:

This course introduces students to devising—the creation of original theatre pieces through collaboration and improvisation. Students will become familiar with a number of different approaches to performance creation and will have opportunities to develop their skills as theatre makers through classroom exercises, rehearsals and in-class presentations. Projects include experiments in site-specific theatre, digital theatre and physical theatre. Throughout the course, students will work on articulating the artistic and sociopolitical goals of their devised performances.
