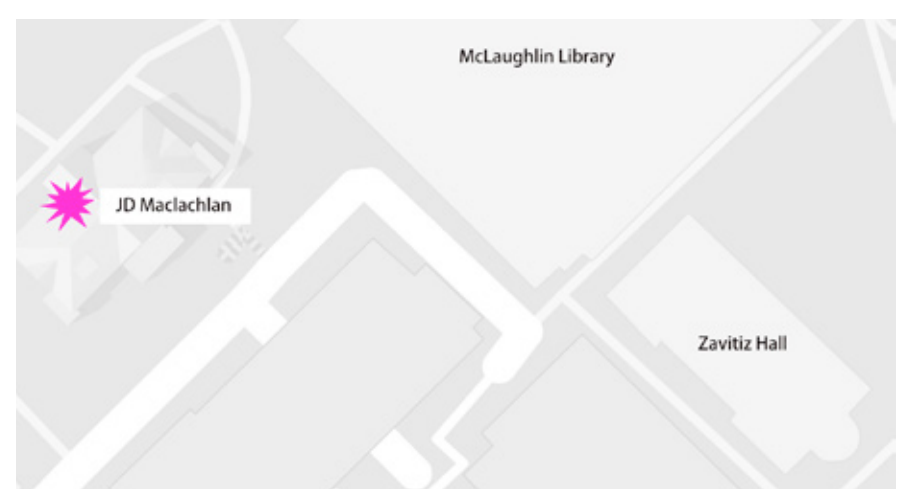
Tanya Lukin-Linklater
