

## **Student Instructors**

Doctoral students are eligible to teach a course as the instructor of record, as part of their PhD program, after they have completed their OQE. Arrangements can usually be made to have this course be taught in the first Fall or Winter semester after their OQE (i.e. in the student's third year), although this is subject to the consent of the student's Advisory Committee and the availability of appropriate courses.

1. Students can only be assigned a course for which no one has, or intends to exercise, a Right of First Refusal. [Letter of Understanding #3, Collective Agreement between CUPE 3912, Unit #2, and the University of Guelph.]
2. Students do not acquire a Right of First Refusal when teaching as a Student Instructor, i.e. as part of their program.
3. Students can teach as a Student Instructor only once during their doctoral program. [Section 11.08(a)(v), Collective Agreement between CUPE 3912, Unit #2, and the University of Guelph.]
4. Courses assigned to students as Student Instructors do not have to be posted. [Section 11.08(a)(v), Collective Agreement between CUPE 3912, Unit #2, and the University of Guelph.]

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
