Microsoft Stream

- Easily trim videos
- Very similar to Youtube but University of Guelph students must log-in
- Transcript allows students to easily search and find important topics (AODA compliant)

Discussions Forums

- Allows learners to reflect and develop critical-thinking skills
- Learners can explore topics at their own pace
- Students can easily engage with each other
