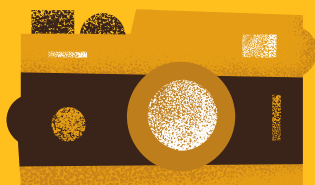

## Digital Story Telling



Digital Story Telling is the combination of topics/subjects relevant to the course and digital learning, by utilizing video design tools and audio recording software to tell a story based on a person, place, trend, or anything you would like!

## Public Performances and Analysis Online



While group public performances are restricted, they can still be performed online with the right organization and tools, such as the combination of video meeting software and a live background as well! Performance Analysis can then be done from other students in the form of feedback, or personal self-assessments.

## Reading Logs and Article Analysis



Reading Logs allow students to write down key definitions and terms that they have found in their readings. The log can then be used as a reflective resource when completing other tasks and projects, such as an article analysis.

## Research and Response Papers



Research papers are a valuable asset as they can cover a broad range of subjects, where each student can have a different topic. Response papers on the other hand can be used in response to articles, or other students research papers to encourage effective feedback from one peer to the next.
