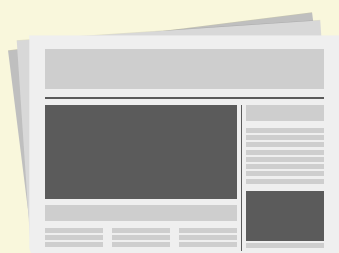


DIGITAL LIVE COMPOSITIONS

Recordings/Reenactments of specific pieces from any century of time allow for a comprehensive understanding of the meaning and key aspects of said piece.

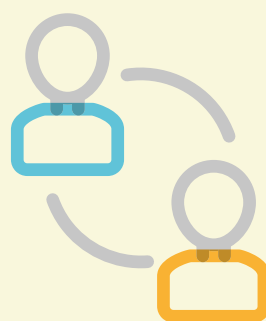


RESEARCH PAPERS
