Sara Angelucci is a Toronto-based artist working in photography, video, audio, and installation. Over the years her projects have developed from a range of archival materials, from personal photographs and films to anonymous and found images. Her work considers the ways in which photographs are constructed to tell stories, create histories, and participate in memorialization.

Angelucci was the Director of Gallery 44 Centre for Contemporary Photography from 1998 – 2008. She is currently an Adjunct Professor in Photography, School of Image Arts, Ryerson University and is the Curatorial Coordinator for the Student Gallery at the Ryerson Image Centre. Her work is represented by Stephen Bulger Gallery in Toronto, and Patrick Mikhail Gallery in Montreal. (sara-angelucci.ca)
