ADDING DETAILS

- While your video is uploading, you can add your video name, description, language, and thumbnail to your video. You can also add a personal thumbnail.
- In the Permission section, you can allow who can see your video. You can set it to a specific person or a group.
- In the Options section:
 - You can turn on the People section, which will automatically identify the people who are in the video. You can also turn on the comments so people can comment on your video.
 - You can also add captions to your videos. You can choose a language that you want, and you have to upload a translation file for that language.

Step 4

PUBLISH/SHARE

- After the video is uploaded, you can now click on the publish button to publish it. You can also share the video after you published it.
- After you published it, you can click on the title link, which is on top of the Detail Section. It will direct your published video website.
- Now you can copy and paste the published link into CourseLink.
