

Transcript of “BComm Experience: Leadership & Organizational Management”

Summary

Descriptive Transcript

You take a case you analyze it with peers and then you present your analytics you are judged by numerous judges other people can come in and watch you there's a lot of pressure but the same time there's so much reward.
