Dr. Julie LaRoche is a CRC Tier 1 at Dalhousie University. Dr. LaRoche's research has contributed significantly to promoting the application of molecular biology techniques to study marine biogeochemistry. Significant advances were made in the study of marine nitrogen fixation and the biodiversity of marine nitrogen fixers, the physiological response of diatoms to iron limitation and the response of natural microbial communities to nutrient limitation.
