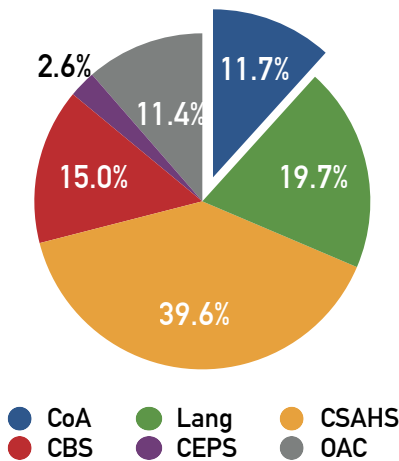

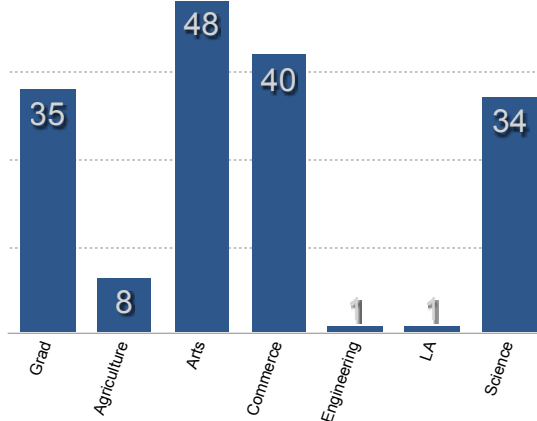

**FORMAL STUDY ABROAD (Total 273)**



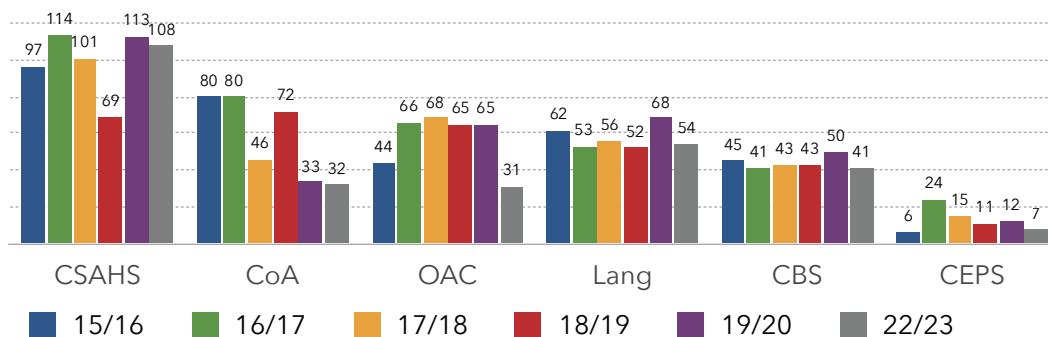
**INCOMING EXCHANGE (Total 167)**
