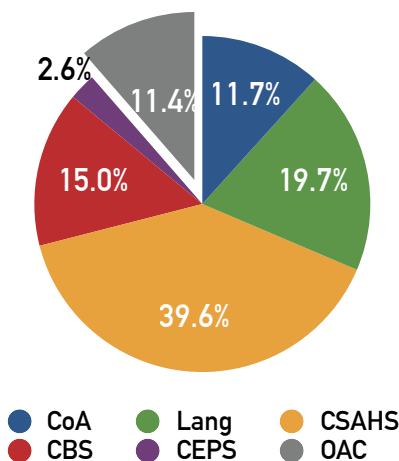

273 in formal study abroad programs (exchange, field school, and research internships run by CIP)

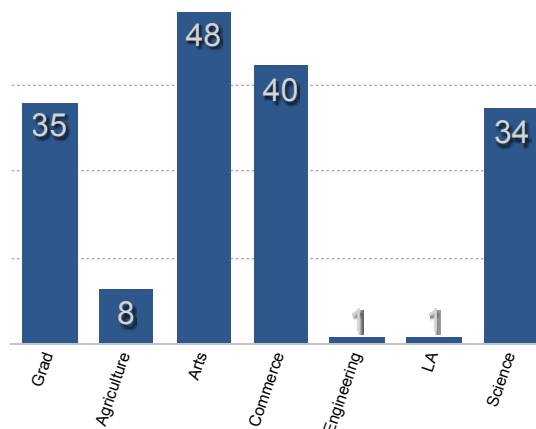

FORMAL STUDY ABROAD (Total 273)



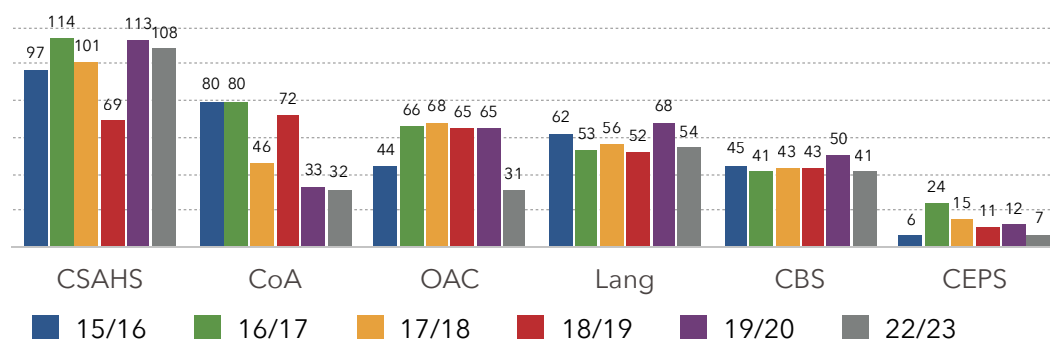
INCOMING EXCHANGE (Total 167)

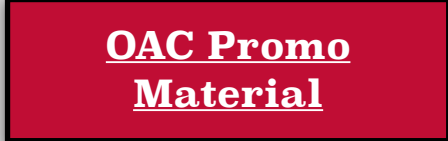
