Why?

 To maintain and enhance your quality as scholars

 It's consistent with the University's mandate of the Teaching & Learning committee



#### Criteria

- Description of goals/objectives of scholarly activity
- Links goals and objectives to measurable outcomes
- Articulates how the fellowship will maintain or enhance your quality as a scholar
- Identifies the subsequent contributions you will make to the University's teaching programs



## A strong application ...

 Provides sufficient description of goals/objectives of scholarly activity

- What question are you trying to answer?
- Or problem you are hoping to address?
- SMART goals are specific, measurable, achievable, realistic and time limited



#### A strong application ...

Answers the questions:

- ✓ How will you know you have achieved your objectives?
- What will be the subsequent contributions that this fellowship will make to the University's teaching programs?
  - Impact to your course(s)?
  - ✓Innovation?
  - What will be the benefits to you as a scholar?
