



The Graduate Student's Association (GSA) has arranged for Black, Indigenous, LGBTQ+, specially-abled and international graduate students to apply for a DEI (Diversity, equity, and inclusion) fund that students may receive as a result of unexpected emergency/compassionate circumstances. The fund provides a maximum of \$200 for expenses that are incurred due to extenuating circumstances. These include:

- ✓ Dental and Vision emergencies; Cane, cast, crutches, splints, wheelchair rentals, Hospital expenses.
- ✓ Domestic Utilities (hydro, gas, water, internet); Groceries, Technology (tablet, laptop), Rent Relief, Theft
- ✓ Any medical emergency expenses for children not covered by OHIP and UHIP.
- ✓ Emergency Transportation (This criterion is limited to in-town and in-province travel for emergencies) Car rental, Cab fare, public transportation.
- ✓ Other compassionate/emergency reasons.

Graduate students may contact GSA VP Finance (gsavpfin@uoguelph.ca) or GSA Office Manager (gsa@uoguelph.ca) prior to making an application for support. If additional support is needed, the VP of Finance will assist students in finding other sources of funding that students are eligible for.

The DEI Committee consists of the GSA Vice-President of Finance, the International Student Advisor and the Black Student Representatives.
