

Available Awards / Scholarships for HFTM Students

Due January 31st, 2018

Elizabeth M. (Betty) Upton Memorial Travel Grant \$1000

Eligibility: Established in memory of Elizabeth M. Upton, a faculty member in the School of Hospitality, Food and Tourism Management, who played a key role in the development of the School and was instrumental in the development of the Institutional Foodservice Management major. Selection will be equally based on academic achievement, demonstrated relevance of the travel to the student's academic studies and cost of travel.

Method of Application: Apply by May 15th to the HFTM Awards Committee including a description of the travel, a description of the relevance of the travel to your program of study, and a budget including other expected sources of funding.

Big Picture Conferences Scholarship \$1700

Eligibility: Big Picture Conferences is dedicated to connecting people through the synergistic production of annual conferences and networking events for the Canadian hospitality industry. Students registered in any program offered by the School of Hospitality, Food and Tourism Management who have completed between 4.5 and 15.0 credits and have acquired work experience in the hotel industry. The student who has demonstrated dedication to the hotel industry (e.g. the student's work experience includes different positions and/or various employers within the hotel industry). Current or completed work experience(s) may include, but are not limited to, co-op education placements, full-time employment, part-time employment or summer employment. In the event of a tie, the award will go to the student with the highest cumulative average.

Method of Application: Apply to the HFTM Awards Committee (hftaward@uoguelph.ca) by January 31 with a resume outlining their experience in the hotel industry and a profile describing their hotel-related work experience.

Dorothy Shantz Memorial Scholarship - Third Year - \$900

Established by the Canadian Hospitality Foundation for students involved in student organizations within the School of Hospitality and Tourism Management.

Eligibility: Student registered in a major offered by the School of Hospitality and Tourism Management who has completed at least 11.00 credits but no more than 14.50 credits (normally in the sixth semester) with at least a 70% average in the last two full-time equivalent semesters and who shows enthusiasm for the foodservice industry. The recipient must have demonstrated leadership ability by holding an executive position on a student organization of the School of Hospitality and Tourism Management (CAFP, HAC, HFTMSA, PCMA, Slow Food).

Method of Application: Apply to the HTM Awards Committee (hftaward@uoguelph.ca) by January 31 using the standard HTM scholarship application form.

Dorothy Shantz Memorial Scholarship – Fourth Year - \$900

Established by the Canadian Hospitality Foundation for students involved in student organizations within the School of Hospitality and Tourism Management.

Eligibility: Student registered in a major offered by the School of Hospitality, Food and Tourism Management who has completed at least 15.00 credits (normally in the eighth semester) with a minimum 70% cumulative average and who shows enthusiasm for the foodservice industry. The recipient must have demonstrated leadership ability by holding an executive position on a student organization within the School of Hospitality, Food and Tourism Management (CAFP, HAC, HFTMSA, PCMA, Slow Food).

Method of Application: Apply to the HFTM Awards Committee (hftaward@uoguelph.ca) by January 31 using the standard HFTM scholarship application form.

Fairmont Hotels and Resorts Scholarship 2 - \$1000

Eligibility: The Fairmont Hotels and Resorts Scholarships support upper year students who intend to pursue a career in the hotel hospitality field. Students registered in any program offered by the School of Hospitality, Food and Tourism Management who have completed at least 10.0 credits and have completed hospitality-related employment, co-op education placements or extracurricular or volunteer activities.

Method of Application: Students should apply to the HFTM Awards Committee (hftaward@uoguelph.ca) by January 31 with a resume and a one to two page letter outlining their interest in the hotel hospitality field, and how the values of respect, integrity, teamwork and empowerment are reflected in their education and experience to date.

Frank Hughes Memorial Scholarship - \$1000 (tentative at the moment)

Eligibility: A student in the B.Comm. program in any major offered by the School of Hospitality and Tourism Management who has completed between 11.0 and 14.5 course credits. The winner will be chosen on the basis of three criteria in the following order of emphasis: 1) industry work experience; 2) academic achievement; and 3) extracurricular involvement.

Instructions: Apply to the HFTM Awards Committee (hftaward@uoguelph.ca) by January 31st using the HFTM Awards Application Form. Include a resume outlining relevant industry work experience and a detailed list of extracurricular involvement.

Fred Lai Yin Kan Memorial Scholarship - \$1000

Eligibility: Students in the B.Comm. program in any major offered by the School of Hospitality, Food and Tourism Management who have completed a minimum of 5.0 credits. The award winner will be chosen on the basis of two criteria in the following order of emphasis: 1) Essay and 2) involvement in the HFTM program through involvement in School activities for example with HFTMSA, Hornblower magazine, career night, etc. and/or demonstrated entrepreneurial experience. In a case of a tie the individual with the highest cumulative average will receive the award

Method of Application: Apply to the HFTM's Awards Committee by January 31st using the HFTM Awards Application Form. Include a resume outlining relevant experience and a 500 word essay describing an experience or program, that one has been involved with, which has built character and shaped the person the applicant is today.

Greater Toronto Hotel Association Scholarship - \$1000

Eligibility: HFTM Awards Committee will invite the students with the top five grades in the previous winter semester's offering of HTM*2100 to submit a statement of up to 500 words explaining their interest in the lodging industry. The recipient will be selected based on academic performance and the statement of interest

Application: Students who meet the criteria will be contacted by Awards Committee.

HAFA HFTM Alumni Association Scholarship – 2nd Year Student - \$1000

Eligibility: One scholarship will be awarded to a student who has completed at least 7.00 credits (but no more than 10.50 credits). Applicants must have at least a 70% average in the last two full-time equivalent semesters. The recipient must have participated in extracurricular activities at the University of Guelph

Method of Application: Please submit your application by email to hftaward@uoguelph.ca by January 31 using the standard HFTM scholarship application form to the HFTM Awards Committee.

HAFA HFTM Alumni Association Scholarship – 3rd Year Student - \$1000

Eligibility: One scholarship will be awarded to a student who has completed at least 11.00 credits (but no more than 14.50 credits). Applicants must have at least a 70% average in the last two full-time equivalent semesters. The recipient must have participated in extracurricular activities at the University of Guelph

Method of Application: Please submit your application by email to hftaward@uoguelph.ca by January 31 using the standard HFTM scholarship application form to the HFTM Awards Committee.

Mandarin Restaurants Scholarship - \$1000

Eligibility: This scholarship will be awarded to a student that demonstrates a continued interest in the food service industry. Students in a major of the B.Comm. program offered by the School of Hospitality and Tourism Management who have completed at least 11.0 credits but no more than 14.5 credits with a minimum 75% in the last two full-time equivalent semesters.

Method of Application: Apply to the HFTM Awards Committee (hftaward@uoguelph.ca) by January 31 using the standard HFTM Awards Application Form and include a statement of up to 500-words explaining your interest in the food service industry. The recipient will be selected based on academic performance and the statement of interest.

Shirley Louie Memorial Scholarship - \$500

Offered by the Canadian College and University Food Services Association (CCUFSA) to honour Shirley Louie, a long-time member and provide a \$500 scholarship.

Eligibility: Student in their final year of a major offered by the School of Hospitality and Tourism Management, with a minimum 70% average and an interest in the food service industry.

Method of Application: Apply by January 31st to the HFTM Awards committee (hftaward@uoguelph.ca) using the standard HFTM scholarship application form and provide a maximum 500-word statement on your reasons for interest in the foodservice industry, a resume and any information you think that the HFTM Awards Committee should take into consideration.

Smart Serve Ontario Scholarships – 2@ \$675

Application is not required

Established by Smart Serve Ontario, a non-profit organization dedicated to promoting the responsible service of alcohol.

Eligibility: Students in the B.Comm. program in a major offered by the School of Hospitality and Tourism Management who have completed between 6.0 and 8.0 course credits with the highest cumulative average and the Smart Serve certification program.

Method of Application: No application is required HFTM Awards Committee will contact the students.

Smart Serve Ontario Leadership Scholarship - \$8000

Eligibility: Students must be enrolled in any major offered by the School of Hospitality, Food and Tourism Management, who have completed a minimum of 2.00 credits to a maximum of 4.00 credits at the time of application, and a minimum 75% cumulative average. Must have completed Smart Serve certification and demonstrated leadership in the Hospitality Industry as indicated in a one (1) page letter which indicates / demonstrates leadership in the hospitality industry.

Method of Application: Students apply to HFTM awards committee with a 1-page letter summary letter of demonstrated leadership in the hospitality industry deadline **January 31st, 2018**
