The award is an amazing honour I've been very lucky in my career and I think a huge part of my growth has come through really helping others excel and I've been very lucky in my jobs I've watched young people and I've mentored them and I've coached them in a very dynamic industry and you know what I found out about this the honour of the award I kinda felt that it's a recognition of just kind of giving back and I'm very hopeful that this will also give me an opportunity to speak to more people to talk about the industry I think in many respects our industry is misunderstood and it needs a better brand and perhaps this designation will help me speak to those and develop hospitality as a career option for lots of folks both of the undergrad level and at the graduate level.
