

Graduate students from the Department of Human Health and Nutritional Sciences at the University of Guelph made headlines. The students made the news after presenting award nominated talks and posters at Experimental Biology 2018 in San Diego, California.

Presentations were given by graduate students from the University of Guelph on dissection-based audiovisual modules, laboratory manuals and virtual reality videos. The emphasis of the presentations was on the need for supplementary resources in anatomy education. There was a lot of interest in direction-based videos designed to enhance program efficiency and engagement. PhD candidate William Albabish presented both his poster on the use of virtual reality as well as his award nominated video on the benefits of dissection based videos.
