
Hearing Loss Prevention Program Training

This is a basic training session on noise hazards in the workplace and the University's [Hearing Loss Prevention Program](#) [1]. Participants will gain an understanding of the following topics:

- Definition of noise
- Health effects of exposures to hazardous noise levels
- Regulatory requirements under O. Reg. 381/15
- Noise hazard assessments
- Noise controls
- Use, care and fitting of hearing protection devices
- Audiometric testing; and
- Roles and responsibilities under the University's Noise Control and Hearing Conservation Program

The course also includes hands-on training on proper fitting of foam ear plugs.

Target Audience: Employees who work in noise hazard areas and are required to wear hearing protection devices.
