

Procedures for Registering Service Dogs in Training

DOCUMENATION

The owner/handler of a Service Dog in Training must provide on request the following documentation:

- a) Vaccination: The animal must have up to date immunization against diseases. Animals must wear a rabies vaccination tag.
- b) Training: An owner/handler must provide verification that appropriate training has occurred.

REGISTRATION

- a) Service Animals in Training will be allowed only from the following organizations and the number of trainers will be limited as follows:
 - Lions Foundation of Canada Dog Guides (7)
 - Autism Dog Services (7)
 - National Service Dogs (7)
- b) The organizations will be responsible for limiting the number of trainers on campus.
- c) Individuals who have been approved to have a Service Animal in Training on campus must register with Campus Community Police.
- d) Handlers of Service Animals in Training registered by Campus Community Police must ensure that their animal is on a leash and under control of the handler, is wearing the appropriate vests and capes at all times, and carry the appropriate documentation provided both by the Training organization as well as by Campus Community Police.
- e) Handlers are prohibited from transferring such control to another person outside of the organization to which they are affiliated, requesting the assistance of non-affiliated persons in supervising or controlling their Service Animal in Training or otherwise leaving the presence of their animal for any period of time while on University of Guelph facilities.
