To: All Retirees in the University Group Benefit plan with older design

Subject: May 2016 University Group Benefit Renewal (older plan design)

The University of Guelph has finalized the Group Benefits Renewal with Sun Life for the upcoming policy year starting May 2016. As you may know, Sun Life is the group insurance carrier for the University's Extended Health Care (EHC) and Dental insurance benefits.

Effective May 2016, the EHC premiums will increase by 3% while Dental premiums will continue to remain unchanged for the 9th consecutive year. The EHC plan's increase is required to adjust for past claims experience, trends, insurer's administration expenses, and required insurance reserves. The 3% increase will apply to both the University's as well as your share of the premiums.

The new Retiree premium rates noted in the table below, will be deducted from your pension payment starting at the end of May 2016. CIBC Mellon will also provide you with a Payment Advice notice, at that time.
