- <u>Course Waiver Form</u> Semester: Fall term (recommended)
  Summer term registration is possible if field component ends before July 1<sup>st</sup>, but requires university summer term tuition fee. Field course coordinator consent required.
  Winter term registration is possible if student is in co-op work term in Fall. Field course coordinator consent required.
- Field Safety and Indemnification Form [completed and signed]
  Students will also need to agree to abide by safety instructions provided by the instructors and field station staff.

## **Additional Notes for OUPFB Applicants**

- If you intend to apply for more than one field course, each application requires a separate application package and \$350.00 deposit cheque.
- Where applicable, we encourage you to list multiple options you are interested in to increase your chances of getting a spot in a field course.
- Your deposit cheque will only be cashed IF you are accepted into a course. If you are accepted into the course but later change your mind, your deposit may not be refunded unless we are able to find a replacement student. If you must withdraw for medical or other compassionate circumstances, with documentation, a refund will be considered in such a case.
- Acceptance decisions will be made by the end of February.
- For accepted students, you will need to pay the balance of the course fee to the hosting university for OUPFB courses according to instructions provided by the course instructor.
- Students will be refunded the full course cost if a field course is cancelled by the host institution. Students will not receive transportation cost due to a cancellation and are strongly advised to have travel insurance.
- Students taking field courses outside of Canada must also take and show they have passed an online pre-departure orientation program through the Centre for International Programs, called <u>Depart Smart</u>. Please complete <u>Other International Academic Travellers Registration for</u> <u>Students</u> under the 'Other International Academic Travellers – Individual Registration' drop down.
