IBIO*4521/4522 is a two semester (F,W), 2.0-credit undergraduate thesis course in which students conduct comprehensive, independent research under the supervision of a faculty member. This course is primarily for students who intend to pursue postgraduate work. To be enrolled in this course, students must have a minimum cumulative average of **80%**. Students who do not meet the minimum cumulative average but still wish to gain experience with research are encouraged to take one or more research project courses (e.g. IBIO*4500, IBIO*4510).

To obtain approval to register for IBIO 4521/4522, complete all sections of this form and then obtain the signature of the faculty member who has agreed to act as your Thesis Advisor* ***See attached list of eligible professors.**

Submit this and a course waiver form to the course coordinator, Dr. Nick Bernier, SSC 3467. This will occur during the course selection period in the preceding winter semester.

Note: The advisor must be a faculty member in IBIO**.
