Over a 20-year period (1999-2019), approximately 4,000 students graduated from the Ontario Agricultural College's (OAC) graduate programs. The post-secondary sector includes all public and private universities and colleges, as well as institutions that are focused on pursuing education, research and scholarships.

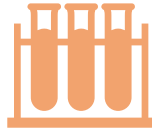

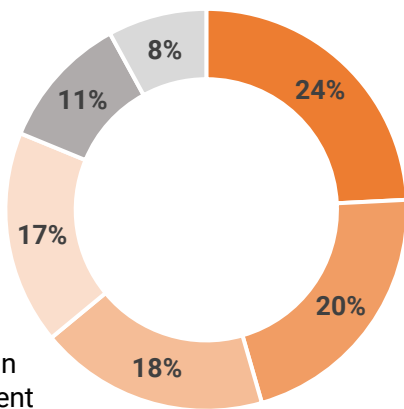
