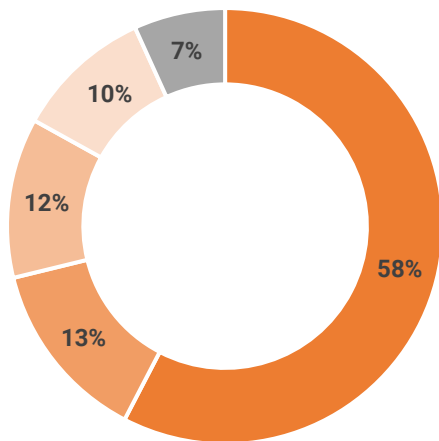
### Job titles of SEDRD PhD graduates in 2018-2019.
