

Psychology – Assistant Professor Position (Clinical Psychology: Applied Developmental Emphasis)

University of Guelph

The Department of Psychology at the University of Guelph invites applications for a tenure-track assistant professor position in child and adolescent clinical psychology. Our CPA accredited program, **Clinical Psychology: Applied Developmental Emphasis**, stresses a developmental approach to clinical psychology with children and adolescents. The appointment is to begin January 1, 2017 or earlier.

We welcome applicants with research expertise from any domain of child and/or adolescent clinical psychology. Applicants should have a strong research profile, evidence of an emerging scholarly record, and a commitment to pursuing external funding. The successful candidate will be expected to provide both research and clinical supervision to graduate students in the CPADE program and to teach at the undergraduate and graduate levels, and contribute to departmental service.

Applicants must be receiving or have a PhD from a CPA or APA accredited program and must be registered or become registered as a clinical psychologist in the province of Ontario within 2 years of beginning the position.

Our facilities include the Department's Centre for Psychological Services, which provides psychological services to children, adolescents, and families in the Guelph and surrounding community, assessment and therapy skills training for graduate students under the supervision of faculty and clinic staff, and a setting to conduct research. Our clinical program is flanked by three other applied graduate programs in the Department: Applied Social Psychology, Industrial/Organizational Psychology, and Neuroscience and Applied Cognitive Science.

Guelph is a progressive university town consistently ranked among the most liveable cities in Canada. Guelph's award-winning Community Energy Initiative, strong neighbourhoods, community wellness initiative and dynamic artistic community make it a great place to live, work, and raise a family. It is uniquely located to provide easy access to London, Toronto, Hamilton and the Waterloo region.
