### Description

ACS PRF research grant programs support fundamental research in the petroleum field, and development of the next generation of engineers and scientists through advanced scientific education. Research areas supported include chemistry, the earth sciences, chemical and petroleum engineering, and related fields such as polymers and materials science. Membership in the American Chemical Society is not a requirement or a factor in awarding ACS PRF grants.

#### New Directions (ND)

- The New Directions Grants Program aims to stimulate a *new direction* of research for established faculty, and to support the careers of their student scientists and engineers. For complete ND details see [New Directions \(ND\) Grants](#) [2].
- Amount: \$110,000 over two years

#### Application submission window

- The submission window for ND will be from Monday, February 15, 2021 to Friday, March 12, 2021 and the submitted proposals will be considered at the October 2021 ACS PRF Committee Meeting.

<b>External Deadline</b>	Friday, March 12, 2021 - 5:00pm	Proposals will be accepted via the ACS portal from noon February 15, 2021 to 5:00 pm EST March 12, 2021. Once the submission window is open principal investigators can add information and save as they work through the application process. They do not have to prepare an entire submission package before engaging the system. An American Chemical Society (ACS) Network User ID which may be obtained free of charge is required to access the system.
