SEED FUNDING for novel, high-risk, high-reward translational research on neurodegenerative diseases of aging

Up to \$300,000 over up to 18 months

NEW FOR 2018/2019

- Budget increased to \$300k/project.
- Complementary

 approaches such as diet,
 physical activity, sleep,
 nutritional supplements,
 speech therapy, and
 cognitive therapy, are now eligible.

- Translational research that helps accelerate the development of therapeutics for neurodegenerative diseases of aging
