FUNDING for transformative, novel, high-risk, high-reward translational research projects

\$200,000 to **\$1,500,000** over up to 3 years

NEW FOR 2019

- No preliminary data is required and instead can be collected as initial steps in the grant.
- Complementary approaches such as diet, physical activity, sleep, nutritional supplements, speech therapy, and cognitive therapy, are now eligible.

APPLICANT must be:

- At or above the level of assistant professor
- At a CRA qualified donee institution located in Canada

- Development of a therapeutic and/or tool, and/or select complementary approaches
- Translational research that helps accelerate the development of therapeutics for neurodegenerative diseases of aging
