## 2024 Advancing Research Impact Fund Livestock Innovation Grants

### Awards

- Six (6) projects – up to \$40,000 each
- Total program funding envelope \$240K
- One year in duration (max 14 months – must end by 30 Nov 2025)

### Purpose

- Promote the participation of farmers, entrepreneurs, industry leaders, and scientists, to co-develop innovative practices and technologies to address livestock priority problems
- Translate current knowledge into practical solutions (TRL 2 → 4)
- Increase the probability of follow-on funding (i.e. OMAFRA, AAFC, NRC, NSERC etc)
- Positively impact the livestock industry in Canada through grass-root collaborations
- Advance solutions that address/improve priority livestock problems in:
  - Biosecurity
  - Farm infrastructure
  - Climate change (adverse weather)
  - Animal health-information systems
  - Animal healthcare delivery

### Scope of Projects

- Early stage applied research to test ideas in priority problem areas
- Translating proven research into near commercial solutions
- Derisking or validating early-stage solutions in the field or in collaboration with farmers
- Advancing social innovation for livestock
- Advancing extension and knowledge mobilization of proven research

### Project Criteria

- Strength and engagement of a diverse project team (farmer-academic-entrepreneur-industry – all participating or advising)
- Fit with the needs of stakeholders (addressing a “priority livestock problem”)
- Quality and probability of real-world tangible impact (high risk acceptable)
- Budget effectiveness
  - eg. 50% salary; 40% consumables; 10% other – avoid large CapEx NMT \$5K
- Logical, clear, reasonable project plan
- Suitability and balance of the KMB plan to support the Work Plan
- Quality of HQP training

Recommended Project End Date	31 Aug 2025 (i.e. 1 year)
Latest Project Completion	30 Nov 2025

## Project Administration

- Collect Food from Thought metrics
- Eligibility Criteria – PI is UofG faculty eligible to hold Tri-Agency funding
- Eligible Expenses – Tri-Agency Financial Administration Guidelines – see budget worksheet
- Reporting Requirements – minimum final report but maybe an interim report if projects are more than one-year duration
