The University needs to review the requests for equipment prior to the official submission to NSERC to maximize resources and minimize duplication. Researchers must submit a complete NOI form to the Research Services Office (RSO) by September 8, 2026.

IMPORTANT: Researchers may participate in one application, either as an applicant or co-applicant, not both. Also, applicants and co-applicants who were successful in the previous year’s RTI competition will be ineligible to apply this year. Therefore, please ensure that all co-applicants listed on your NOI have confirmed that they are participating on **one application only and are eligible**. This applies to co-applicants from other institutions as well. Co-applicants from other institutions will be required to verify their eligibility via completion of an external co-applicant form, at the full application stage.
