The Study:

Stories in Urgent Times: Ecological Emotions, Speculative Futures, and Pedagogical Possibilities with Ontario Youth seeks participants for a study on how youth feel about climate change and envision and prepare for uncertain futures.

Who:

* Identify as a youth (youth is a flexible category, not a fixed age group, if you identify as a youth you are eligible)

- * Are 16 or older
- * Live in Ontario
- * Can participate in English

What and Where:

Participation involves attending a climate cafe, either online or in person, where you will discuss your feelings and experiences of climate change through open-ended questions.

You can also join an optional 5-week online speculative digital storytelling workshop for a few hours each week and participate in two focus groups to review a policy brief and pedagogical guide about climate emotions.

Honorarium:

Participants will receive a \$30 honorarium for attending a climate cafe.
