



Eligibility

- Nominees do not need to be Senators.
- Nominators must come from the same group as the nominee. (i.e. Tenured faculty must be nominated by tenured faculty; full-time staff must be nominated by full-time staff; graduate students must be nominated by graduate students; and undergraduate students must be nominated by undergraduate students).
- Faculty nominees and nominators must hold a tenured appointment at the level of Professor, Associate Professor, or Assistant Professor.
- Professional Librarian nominees and nominators must hold a continuing appointment at the level of Librarian, Associate Librarian or Assistant Librarian.
- Staff nominees and nominators must be regular full-time staff members currently holding a regular full-time non-academic appointment.
- Graduate student nominees and nominators must be registered as full-time or part-time students in the current semester.
Undergraduate student nominees and nominators must be registered as full-time or part-time students in the current semester.

Please note, students who are anticipated to retain their student status until the Chancellor Selection Committee completes its function will be given preference.
