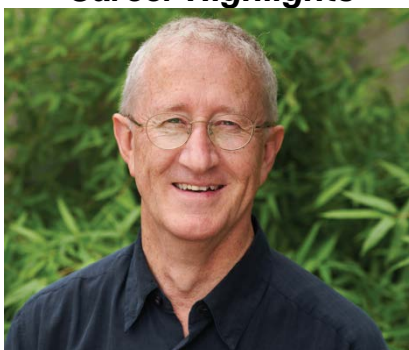


Wayne J. Caldwell, PhD, MCIP, RPP
