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and that's a double weight course for most of you it will be

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the only double weight course you take other courses

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electives you know which electives do I take where do I find electives

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that's a that's a really good site to start if you want to change your

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major so if you've come in from one major you want to go

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into another one this is a good place to look at talks

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about the process is one thing I will say

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is that if you're in Co op.

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or you want to apply into klopp there's a separate process for that

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so that it's mentioned in the website there about

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what you need to be kind of mindful love but you can look through that

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information as far as changing majors an additional link if you

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links here will just take you to the major OK.

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so just kinda be mindful of that. It looks a little confusing.

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because both majors and minors are listed there at the same time.

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so just make sure that when you follow along with that.

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you're clicking on the right place. So let's assume.

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Just for the sake of example that we've.

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clicked on marketing and it's marketing management. So this is actually.

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the degree program. Now what?

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it does is up at the top what?

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it will do is it gives you kind of a breakdown.

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of how the program is set up, so the degree requirements.

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you need to do 20 credits in total an.

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13 courses are required, core courses 2.

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5, or restricted electives. You've got the business **** core symbol marion.

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Mirage, who's here from the.

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Business Card Element Center is going to talk about that a little bit later on then.

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you've got liberal education free elective, so this essentially is.

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a snapshot of what it that you need to do to get your degree.

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from Guelph. I'll talk a little bit about sort of what each of.

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categories are required core courses.

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These are courses that you must do to get your degree.

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so that includes statistics math.

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math micro macro intro to finance operations strategic

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anagement. These are courses for which there is. There are no options.

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right? You must do them.

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In order to graduate with your degree, the next slide I'll.

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kind of show you how that breaks down into the actual schedule restricted.

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electives excuse me.

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Restricted electives are a little bit different. These are mandatory.

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courses that you must do, however.

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you're working from lists, so you.

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the list might say you must do one of the five courses.

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Which of the five you do entirely up to you, but you have to do at.

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least one of them, OK?

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management 1100 as I say well mary and uh talk

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liberal education electives and free.

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electives, those are where you have options.

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You have choice liberal education.

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is can be any year level first.

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year to 4th year doesn't matter it can. It can't be business.

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based if you, when you're in the calendar if you click.

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on the link for liberal education, it'll tell you what courses.

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ou what courses you can't use for liberal education and

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What it does is it pretty much lays out for you semester by semester.

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what you're going to be doing OK?

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so as you go through each semester.

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You can kind of see what is it that I should be taking in the fall of 1st.

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year winter of 2nd year of.

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ll of 2nd year, winter of 2nd year. So you can kind of follow.

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a sequence. Couple things to keep in mind with your schedule to studies.

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One is that it's an order of operations so.

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it's an order in which you take courses in order to meet prerequisites.

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when courses.

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are offered. One thing to remember is that golf is a semester.

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at school, but not every courses offered every semester.

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So for example, for those of you in accounting.
