Nominating Letter: The Nomination Letter must be written by a current member of the University community. It should provide a description of contributions and achievements made by the nominee(s) to undergraduate academic advising at the university. It should also describe how the nominee(s) qualifies as an outstanding in the field of academic advising. The letter must be signed, dated, and include the degree program of the Nominator.

Letters of Support: Letters of Support must be written by people other than the Nominator. A maximum of five supporting letters will be reviewed by the Selection Committee, of which a minimum of two must be written by currently registered undergraduate students. Each Letter of Support must indicate how the supporter knows of the work of the nominee(s). All Letters of Support must include the name of the person who wrote the letter, their signature, and the date the letter was written. Letters of Support written by currently registered undergraduate students must include the student's degree program.
