Poster sessions

Delegates are invited to bring posters to the Summit (see instructions for Poster presentations if you want to reserve a poster board to display your poster and want to have the abstract of the poster published in the Summit brochure).

Posters will be shown in the concourse of Rozanski Hall so that people can read them during breaks. It is not mandatory to stand by your poster, but delegates will be around at the coffee/tea and lunch breaks.

At Saturday lunch, there will be an opportunity to allocate a table for people to come and learn more about the work displayed in the poster.

Campus Food Tours

A number of tours of facilities on campus working directly or indirectly to alleviate hunger and poverty will be available. These will include tours of the Student Food Bank, the Organic Farm and various operations focus on sustainability including food waste recycling.
